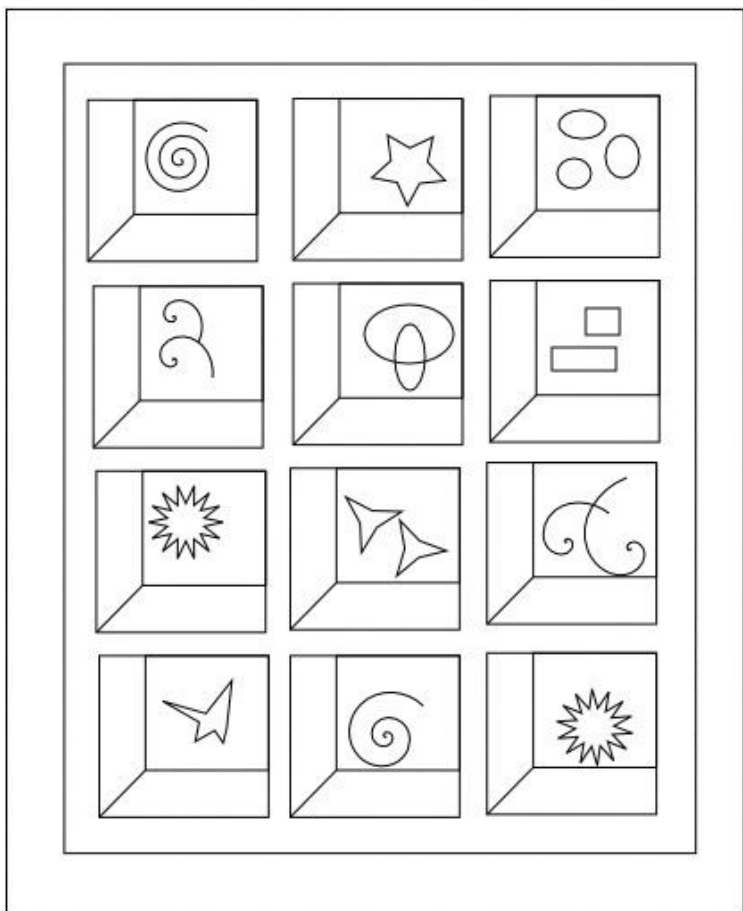


# Easy I-Spy (also known as Attic Windows) by Cheryl Petreman

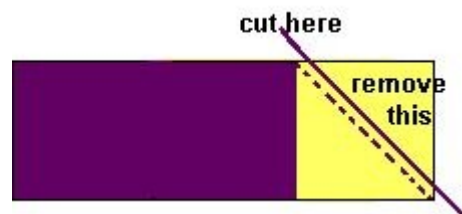
Each **Window**, requires the following:

- 6" square of a novelty fabric
- 2.5" x 6" rectangle of window ledge fabric A
- 2.5" square of window ledge fabric A
- 2.5" x 8" rectangle of window ledge fabric B

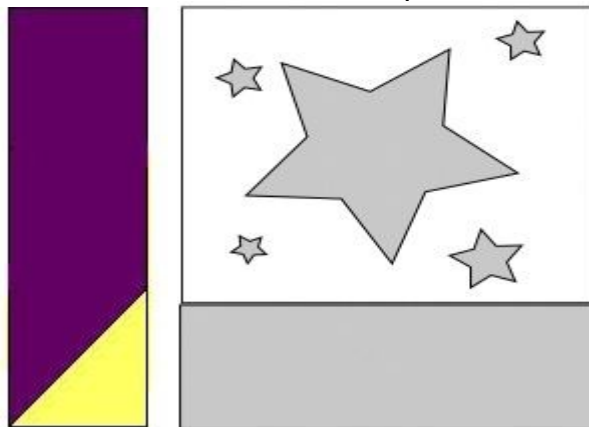
Using a pencil, draw a line diagonally across the 2.5" square of fabric B and place it right sides together on top of the end of fabric A:



Sew on the drawn line & cut 1/4" above the seam:



Sew the 2.5" x 6" piece of fabric A to the novelty fabric. Sew the constructed piece to the side.



After constructing all your *windows*, add sashing & borders to make your quilt the desired size. Note that the sashing looks best if it is either narrower or wider than the window ledges.
